

Jurying Standards for Stone Mills Museum

1. All work displayed for sale must be of the artists or craftsmen's work, executed by the artist/exhibitor. Our goal is to provide a venue for high quality arts and crafts to be sold and displayed
2. Work should demonstrate skill and mastery of the medium.
3. Traditional crafts should be historically correct and well executed.
4. Dried/Silk flowers and materials must be arranged and are not to be sold in bulk.
5. Commercial garments must have your own designs or workmanship.
6. Ceramics-including the design, firing, and finishing-must be primarily the work of the exhibitor.
7. Candles must be handcrafted and artistically designed.
8. The following are NOT ACCEPTABLE: Direct buy and sell, Objects made from commercial kits, molds or patterns. imported or manufactured goods.
9. Jury decisions will be based on Creativity, Workmanship, Continuity of work and an Overall appearance of display. Decisions will be final. The jury will view only submitted images and application forms. Please do not send additional photographs or resumes. Photos needed with the application; two pictures of you working on different phases of your work, a picture of your booth and several pictures of your product.
10. Displays should be set up on Thursday between 7:00am & 8:00pm. On Friday, Saturday and Sunday all vehicles must be off the grounds by 8:00am sharp as buyers start lining up early to buy your products. All crafter's vehicles must be parked near the wind mill on the other side of the tractor tract so your customers have choice parking.
11. Displays can not be taken down or packed away prior to 4:00 Sunday; some buyers wait to the last minute to get to your booth.
12. The wrist bands in your registration packets must be worn in order to get back into the gates, otherwise you will be charge entrance fee.
13. As you see in your packet, fees for your booth have raised to \$10.00 per front foot, due to a severe raise in our liability insurance and utilities. We found it necessary to do this in order to keep our museum open for events such as this one.
